Saturday, October 21, at 5:15 PM, the Tallgrass Film Festival will be showing the documentary Forever 'B' in Venue 332 at the Wichita Scottish Rite.

In 1974, in Pocatello, Idaho, 12 year old Jan Broberg was kidnapped by her family's friend and neighbor. Out on bail for that kidnapping, Robert Berchtold (Brother 'B' to Jan and her family) abducted Jan a second time, triggering a nationwide FBI manhunt. Using manipulation and brainwashing, Brother 'B' turned Jan against her family, who were also being deceived. Forever 'B' explores the events surrounding these crimes and how they might have been prevented.
